

Throughout this devotional, you will learn how to pray using the P.R.A.Y. acronym! Each of those letters stands for something you can say to God:

P



Praise God by telling Him how awesome He is, and thank Him for different things in your life.

R



Repent is a fancy word for saying you're sorry. It's telling God you're going to stop doing the wrong thing and start doing what He says is right.

A



Ask God for whatever you want and need!

Y



Say **yes** to God and whatever He says is best, even if it's not what you want.

Prayer for Salvation

Around 2,000 years ago, God sent His Son, Jesus, from heaven to Earth to do something very special for you. Jesus lived on Earth for 33 years to show you how to live each day!

He is the perfect leader for your life because He never did anything wrong even though He was tempted in all the ways that you are tempted to do wrong things.

Everyone does wrong things, but your heavenly Father and His Son, Jesus, didn't want you to have to take the punishment for the wrong things you do called sin.

So Jesus took your punishment by dying on a cross. Three days after Jesus died, God raised Him back to life to show everyone that He is stronger than sin and death!

God and Jesus did this for you so that you can be saved from having to spend forever apart from God. God wants to give you the gift of living forever with Him in a perfect place called heaven!

Questions You May Have About Prayer

Why should we pray?

We should pray because God tells us to pray! And anything He says to do is good for us to do even if we don't completely understand why.

Praying also grows our friendship with God. Just like talking with your friends makes you closer, talking with God will help your heart feel closer to Him.

Most importantly, God wants you to talk to Him because He loves you and cares about what's important to you. And He wants to include you in everything He is doing! So when you pray, God will hear you, and it opens the door for you to hear, see, and be a part of God's perfect plan.

Why do we say, "Amen," at the end of our prayers?

The word "amen" means "so let it be" or "it is true." So when you say, "Amen," it shows God that you know He heard your prayer and that you are trusting He will answer it in His perfect way.

What happens if two people ask God for opposite things at the same time? Which one gets what they're asking for?

God is so awesome that He can listen to both people who are praying! And God is able to do anything we ask of Him, but it doesn't necessarily mean He will. Sometimes, God is going to answer with a "yes" while other times, He's going to answer with a "no."

And you might even get a "not right now" from God every once in a while. We may not fully understand how God chooses His answers, but one thing we can know for sure is that He knows what's best for each one of us. And that's exactly what He's going to do!

Why do we say, "In Jesus' name we pray," at the end of our prayers?

Before Jesus died on the cross and came back to life, our sins separated us from God. But because of Jesus, we now have a direct line to our heavenly Father! Romans 8:34 tells us that Jesus is actually sitting next to God in heaven and praying for us. Jesus also made a promise before He went to heaven. He said, "And I will do anything you ask in my name." (John 14:13, NIRV) So we ask for things in Jesus' name because we believe His promise and trust Him to always do what's best for us.

Do we have to close our eyes or fold our hands when we pray?

You can talk to God in any way at any time of the day, so you do not have to do either of these things when you pray, but doing them may be helpful!

Closing your eyes to pray can help you focus on what you're saying without being distracted by the things around you.

The same is true for folding your hands. You can pray in whatever way helps you pay attention and show respect to God as you talk to Him!

Pray About Everything



R-REPENT








P - PRAISE
